The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the feasibility of purchasing land and making a municipal parking lot, and to install parking meters thereon and throughout the city as a means of revenue, and to discuss the paving program with our engineer, Mr. Bostwick.

Mr. Holemon presented his plans for a parking lot on the lot north of his Freezette, with a bath house and facilities for concessions, revenue from which would help pay for the land.

Parking meter representatives quoted prices on meters and possible revenue.

Mayor Fischer said the commissioners would review their views and invited them to return Wednesday March 5 with layouts of parking etc at which time we would invite Mr Mayers of Jacksonville to discuss purchase of land.

Mr. Bostwick presented his specifications and plans for paving streets. He said he would mail us "invitation for bids" and additional plans and specifications early next week. The bids are to be called for paving first and third streets north and first street south.

Commissioner Knoles made a motion, seconded by Commissioner O'Connor, that the paving cost should come out of ad valorem taxes. Ayes: Commissioners Fischer, Jones, Knoles and O'Connor. Nays: Commissioner Jaehne

For all cross streets between Orlando Avenue and A1A. Being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
