



★ General Business BMP Checklist ★

- KEEP your business' stormwater curbs, swales and stormdrains trash & debris free.** Debris can cause stormdrains to clog and back up, potentially flooding streets & buildings.
- CLEAN mats by vacuuming,** not shaking outside shop.
- ROUTE washwater & equipment cleaning solutions to the sanitary sewer system.** Never dispose or pour solvents or cleaning solutions onto driveways, parking lots or streets.
- RESPONSIBLY DISPOSE of construction wastes & hazardous materials – never in curb, drainage swales or stormdrains.**
- BLOW grass clippings back onto grass or landscape areas.**
- USE NATIVE PLANTS & slow-release fertilizers and herbicides.** Water & fertilize sparingly. Do not apply herbicides, pesticides or fertilizers within 50 feet of our waterways or within 10 feet of paved surfaces. Excess nitrogen in the water increases algae blooms and low oxygen water, which cannot support aquatic life.
- KEEP SEDIMENT OR YARD WASTE PILES** at least 1 foot away from curb, driveway or waterway. Cover lightweight or fine material piles to keep from blowing away.
- STORE MATERIALS, STOCKPILES & EQUIPMENT OUT OF RAIN & WIND** when possible. If outdoors, cover with plastic. Drain fluids from equipment left for long-term storage.
- RECYCLE materials** such as glass, aluminum, plastic, newspaper, magazines/catalogs, whitepaper, metal cans, plastic bags and Styrofoam. Most items can be brought home to curbside recycling until a County-wide commercial program is established. See "City Recycling Opportunities" for other recycle options.
