



★ Pool Service BMP Checklist ★

- DISPOSE OF CHLORINE & CHLORINE CONTAINERS PROPERLY.** A very toxic chemical, chlorine must not be allowed to enter a stormdrain or waterway.
- USE POOL CHEMICALS LIKE ACID & ALGAEICIDE WITH CARE.** These chemicals are toxic, particularly if concentrated and cause harm to estuary habitat.
- CLEAN & BACKWASH POOL FILTER PROPERLY.** Diatomaceous earth type filter media is very harmful to aquatic life and should never be discharged into canal or waterway.
- DRAIN POOLS PROPERLY.** Contact the City Stormwater Dept (868-3292) before draining; if sanitary sewer is available it can be used to drain the pool.
- STORE CHEMICALS & EQUIPMENT OUT OF WEATHER.** Never leave pool chemical uncapped and always store under cover and out of the rain. Use funnels to avoid leaks.
- PROPERLY MAINTAIN DECKS.** Use care during deck maintenance whether using cleaning agents or grinding. Keep all cleaning agents away from stormdrains or waterways and sweep all dry debris to keep from being blown onto waterway.
- USE NATIVE LANDSCAPE** around your pool and deck areas. Native plants do not need fertilizers or pesticides that can pollute waterways and pool if improperly applied.
