## ★ Restaurant BMP Checklist ★

- POUR ALL WASHWATER into utility or wash sink.** Never dump washwater onto parking lot, roadway, stormdrain or waterways.
- CLEAN ALL POTS & PANS IN UTILITY SINK.** Never hose down greasy pans onto parking lots, alleys, roadways, stormdrains or waterways.
- CLEAN MATS by vacuuming,** not shaking outside of building.
- WASH FLOORMATS, FILTERS & GARBAGE CANS in a utility sink or grassy area.** Never hose them down in a parking lot, alley or roadway.
- RECYCLE GREASE & OIL or dispose properly.** Never pour into sinks, floordrains or onto parking lot or roadway.
- USE DRY CLEANUP METHODS for spills.** Keep absorbent materials (kitty litter) to assist in containing spill. Never hose down a food or chemical spill.
- STORE MATERIALS out of the rain.**
- KEEP DUMPSTER AREA CLEAN & LID CLOSED.** Never fill it with liquid waste or hose it out onto parking lot or roadways.
- USE REUSABLE serving items rather than disposable.** Use wax paper or pressed cardboard carryout instead of Styrofoam.
- RECYCLE materials** such as glass, aluminum, plastic, newspaper, magazines/catalogs, whitepaper, metal cans, plastic bags and Styrofoam. Most items can be brought home to curbside recycling until a County-wide commercial program is established. See "City Recycling Opportunities" for other recycle options.
