Dishonored checks

The following schedule of fees is hereby established for services provided:

Service fee for dishonored checks 25.00

If the face value does not exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00), thirty dollars (\$30.00), if the face value exceeds fifty dollars (\$50.00) but does not exceed three hundred dollars (\$300.00), forty dollars (\$40.00), if the face value exceeds three hundred dollars (\$300.00), or an amount of up to five (5) per cent of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater.

Research service charge, per hour 17.00

Research service charge related to personnel files, per hour 25.00

(Research service charge--Calculated in fifteen (15) minute increments; excluding the first fifteen (15) minutes, for which there is no charge. If the research is extensive, the service provider may request a fifty (50) per cent deposit.)

Chapter 14. Special Events Fee Schedule.

The following fee schedule is hereby established for all special events unless otherwise waived by the city manager.

"Class A" event.

Event application fee (nonrefundable) \$ 200.00

Event permit fee, per day 500.00

Holiday event permit fee, per day 1,000.00

Performance bond: One thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or twenty-five (25) per cent of fee total whichever is greater.

"Class B" event.

Event application fee (nonrefundable) 200.00

Event permit fee, per day 250.00

Holiday event permit fee, per day 500.00

Performance bond: One thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or twenty-five (25) per cent of fee total whichever is greater.

"Class C" event.

Event application fee (nonrefundable) 35.00

Event permit fee (eight (8) hours) 100.00

Performance bond 250.00

Motion and still photography.

Production fee 200.00

Per day of production fee 75.00

Performance bond: One thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or twenty-five (25) per cent of fee total whichever is greater.

Personnel fees.

The following formula shall be utilized to calculate the fee for city workers assigned to service special events and other approved functions.

The average base salary as of October 1st each year for each job classification, multiplied by 1.5, plus workers compensation, FICA, pension and benefit costs.

Parking meter rental (# of meters × # of hours per day × # of days affected × current rate per hour = Cost)

"Class C"--(late 1--7 days), per day 2.00
