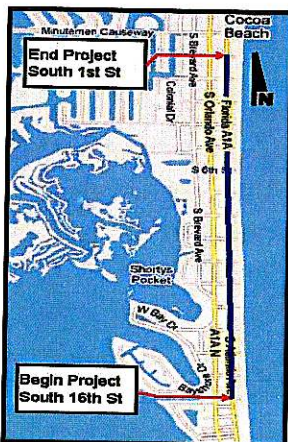

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is holding a public information meeting. It deals with plans to build a new sidewalk from South 16<sup>th</sup> Street to South 1<sup>st</sup> Street, and to reconstruct the existing sidewalk from Orlando Avenue to Wakulla Lane, along northbound S.R. A1A. Both locations are in the City of Cocoa Beach. The FDOT is seeking the participation of interested citizens, businesses and property owners within, and near, the project limits. The public information meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, July 13 at Cocoa Beach City Hall. The meeting begins with an open house at 5 p.m. and includes brief presentations at 5:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. The meeting concludes at 7 p.m. Information about the proposed sidewalk design is available at the meeting. Staff members are also available to discuss the project and answer any questions you may have.

The project improves safety for pedestrians along the S.R. A1A corridor. Construction of the new, eight-foot concrete sidewalk, from South 16<sup>th</sup> Street to South 1<sup>st</sup> Street, also involves clearing the current FDOT right-of-way and installing drainage. The other project, from Orlando Avenue to Wakulla Lane replaces the existing eight-foot asphalt path with an eight-foot concrete sidewalk. Minor drainage improvements are occurring as well. Purchasing additional right-of-way is not anticipated for either segment. The project is funded for construction during the summer of 2014.

Your input is important and valued during this process. Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability or family status.
