Good morning friends and neighbors and welcome to the see-saw weather we have here in February in Cocoa Beach.

We have just received information from FDOT that they have developed conceptual plans for a sidewalk from 520 south to 16th street south which will include some storm drainage work along that area. Work could start as soon as this summer and hopefully will not cause too many problems with your front lawns along the east side of A1A. I attended a Florida Space Coast League of Cities meeting, along with Commissioner Netterstrom, this past Monday and want to remind everyone who wishes to attend, that March 22 is legislative day for our representatives in Tallahassee. So, if you wish to inform them of any of your concerns, you should do so now.

Several priority items are: reclaimed water management; alternative and renewable energy; revenue and expenditure caps; municipal police officer and firefighter pension plans; growth management; transportation; unfunded mandates; economic development; effective public notice; and, subsidized insurance coverage for retirees.

There is a lot on their plate and most topics will affect our own planning here in Cocoa Beach.

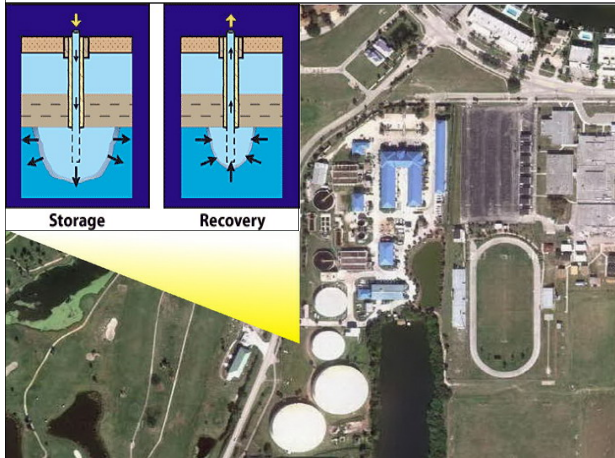
I know some of you have concerns about an ASR well that the city is considering to remedy the problem of excess treated re-use water at different times during the year. The City Manager has been keeping up with all the information that you must know to present the City Commission a solution to our problem of not dumping contaminants into the Banana river.

I have attended several engineering seminars concerning these types of wells and can tell you that I am not convinced as of yet that ASR wells are a correct solution. Please remain sure that I will stay on top of this study and will keep you informed of any decisions made before Cocoa Beach adopts such a program.

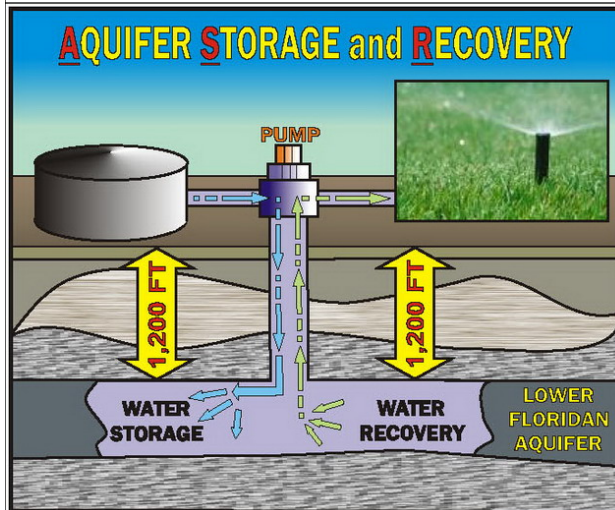
