**HISTORY OF COCOA BEACH DISPLAY BY LOCAL ARTIST JUNE BLUM  
AT COCOA BEACH PUBLIC LIBRARY**

Throughout the month of June, a display entitled “**The History of Cocoa Beach: A Documentation**”, comprised of photography, newspaper clippings, and interviews with residents, has been compiled by local artist and former museum curator, **June Blum**. An artist and pioneer in getting women artists and their works exhibited in mainstream museums, Blum was in the forefront of the women’s art movement in the late 60’s and early 70s and her works have been exhibited nationwide.

On Thursday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, the library will celebrate the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the City of Cocoa Beach at 1:00 PM with a viewing of the new historical documentary about the history of the city, produced by Jim Lasley of Lone Pine Productions, followed by tasty Florida treats.
